For 30 years, ClearWater Conservancy has been promoting conservation and restoration of natural resources in central Pennsylvania. Our members and supporters have been an important part of this organization's incredible successes over the years.



To date we have protected over 4,500 acres of land through conservation easements and conservation partnerships resulting in public ownership of unique habitats and landscapes. In 2009, ClearWater worked with Fred Strouse to protect his Tussey View Farm, where the headwaters of Spring Creek emerge upstream of the Elks Club. In 2010, ClearWater is focusing attention on protecting several of our region's highest priority natural areas, including key forested ridge and gap properties, stream corridor lands, and barrens, as well as the connections these natural areas make between habitats and communities.

In our Riparian Restoration program, we remove invasive species, plant native trees and shrubs, and actively manage newly planted buffer areas along Spring Creek and its tributaries. Our Environmental Outreach program sends students to Millbrook Marsh Nature Center, cleans up sinkholes and streambanks, and teaches many in the community how to be good stewards of the natural world.

ClearWater was honored in 2008 by the Chamber of Business and Industry of Centre County with their first ever Quality of Life Award for our conservation work. This achievement highlights an important aspect of ClearWater's role in the community—our dedication and our ability to establish and maintain positive partnerships with key community decision makers to enhance conservation of our natural resources for the benefit of all.
