10th Annual Watershed Cleanup Day

It was wet and chilly on April 22nd, this year's Watershed Cleanup Day, but that didn't stop dedicated volunteers from heading out, intent to make a difference. With generous help from several local businesses, over **300 enthusiastic volunteers** removed over **335 tons of trash** from central Pennsylvania!

For the 10th consecutive year, fisherman and paddlers took to the streams; church groups, watershed groups, scouts, and 4-H clubs tackled roadsides and headwater streams; and volunteers from local community groups dove into sinkholes to protect and enhance the beauty of our local watersheds.

"We couldn't be more pleased with the turnout", says Jeff Sturniolo, Watershed Cleanup Day Chair and ClearWater board member. "This event demonstrates how important our local water resources are to the community".

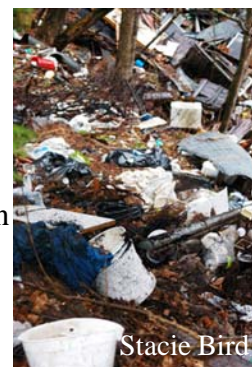
